Dear Student,

The Memorial Scholarships of the Ogunquit Baptist Church exist to support and encourage students from our church family who are seeking higher education. By such support, the church endeavors to affirm the value of higher education and to promote a spirit of mutual care among our church family.

All active members, active participants or children of active members in the life of our congregation who are enrolled at least half-time in a program of study leading to an associate, baccalaureate, master's or doctoral degree at an accredited college or university are eligible to receive this scholarship award The scholarship is awarded annually, and may be received for as many as five academic years.

Applications for scholarships should be made to the church office by May 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Recipients will be notified of their awards in June. Scholarships are dispersed to the student in January, upon verification of enrollment from the school.

Those interested in being considered for a scholarship should provide the information noted below to the church office. Students are asked to update the information each year. First time applicants may be asked to attend an interview to be scheduled through the church office.
